The **Pointer** is always on unless you select a different tool. You can change from any tool back to the **Pointer** by clicking or tapping the **Pointer** button.

You can click or tap the **Cross-Off** button is to cross-off an answer. To undo the cross-off, click or tap on the answer again.

You can click or tap the **Highlighter** button is to highlight a word or sentence. To remove the highlight, click or tap the **Highlighter** button again and select **Clear All**.



You can click or tap the **Sticky Note** button **W** to place a sticky note next to the passages and take notes. To remove the Sticky Note, click or tap the red X on the Sticky Note.

You can click or tap the **Magnifier** button **2** to make the text bigger. Click or tap the **Magnifier** button and select x 1.5 or x 2.0 to turn on the Magnifier tool. Use the gray bars to scroll back and forth. To turn off the **Magnifier** tool, click or tap the **Magnifier** button again and select **Off**.

You can click or tap the Line Guide button with to turn on the Line Guide tool. To use the Line **Guide**, drag the blue handle on the top right corner of the screen to guide you as you read. To turn off the **Line Guide** tool, click or tap the **Line Guide** button again.
